He has studied percussion, drum set, guitar and electronic music production with musical masters in Brazil, Cuba, Chile, Mexico, the UK and the US. He holds a Master's degree in Digital Composition and Performance from the University of Edinburgh in Scotland and. He has composed works for film scores such as The Island President, and recent projects include an algorithmic music composition project using Ableton Live and PGN chess notation. A former ArtCenter South Florida resident artist (2015-2017) specializing in spatial and immersive media, John Henry is also an active DJ and worked as the Music Editor for the Miami Rail from 2017-2018. His most recent immersive music project, In Viridi Lux, was produced with an ALT-B Micro-Grant from Miami Downtown Development Authority in January of 2021. With nearly 20 years of experience as a drummer, DJ, audio engineer, electronic music composer and global dance music John Henry - using his DJ alias "Dale Dale" - employs cutting edge live remixing techniques into his seamless, hybrid DJ sets to both push the boundaries of modern DJ performance and keep bodies moving to a harmonically-balanced mix of old-school and modern dance music.
Artist Statement	As multi-instrumental and multi-media musician, John Henry composes, performs, and produces music across genres ranging from electronica, jazz, funk, global bass and ambient, to avant garde and serialist experimental music. John Henry frequently collaborates with other artists and integrates creative technologies both ancient and modern into his music to create multi-sensory performance experiences. These might be basic wooden percussion, or 3- dimensional infra-red camera-based hand sensors that control a variety of electronic instruments (or instrument parameters) with the literal wave of a hand. John Henry strives to forge new musical connections between genres in order to create an original sound that evokes the movement and progression of music and technology throughout the historical arc of the world order to simultaneously evoke feelings of both deep familiarity and genuine mystery and wonder in the listener.

In Viridi Lux is an immersive and contemplative ambient musical experience designed for one person at a time to experience being immersed in green light while listening to live "green music" played back on a surround sound system in a green tent using the ambisonic music performance software Envelop for Live. It was first produced for public performance with an ALT-B Micro-Grant from Miami Downtown Development Authority in January of 2021.

With Covid social distancing protocols in mind, this first version of In Viridi Lux was designed for one person at a time to sit in the "green room" that I constructed on the sidewalk outside the Olympia Theater on East Flagler Street in downtown Miami, in order to to experience the green light and music.

I would like to expand this performance project into a site-specific installation at the Center for Subtropical Affairs (https://cstamiami.org/), such that at least 10-15 people at a time could fit into the semi-outdoor, spatial audio listening space vs one person at a time in a confined small space in a high foot-traffic zone on fairly busy urban corridor. The space would be outfitted with an ambisonic (3-dimensional) audio playback system (which I already own) and 3-d projection mapping to make the meditative videos more immersive. Target Date for performance would be July 25th, 2022.

The music and sounds incorporated into the performances will use modal improvisation with notes rooted in frequencies that are divisors of the numbers found in the frequency spectrum of green light, that is to say wavelength frequencies between ~ 540–580 THz. These frequency values will then be transposed into the audio domain and accompanied with a variety of green light and video sources that will fill the performance space.

In a time of nearly ubiquitous over-stimulation and increasingly fractured human attention spans, In Viridi Lux will create a tropical, and intimate ambient music and audio-visual experience designed to immerse the audience in green light and music.
